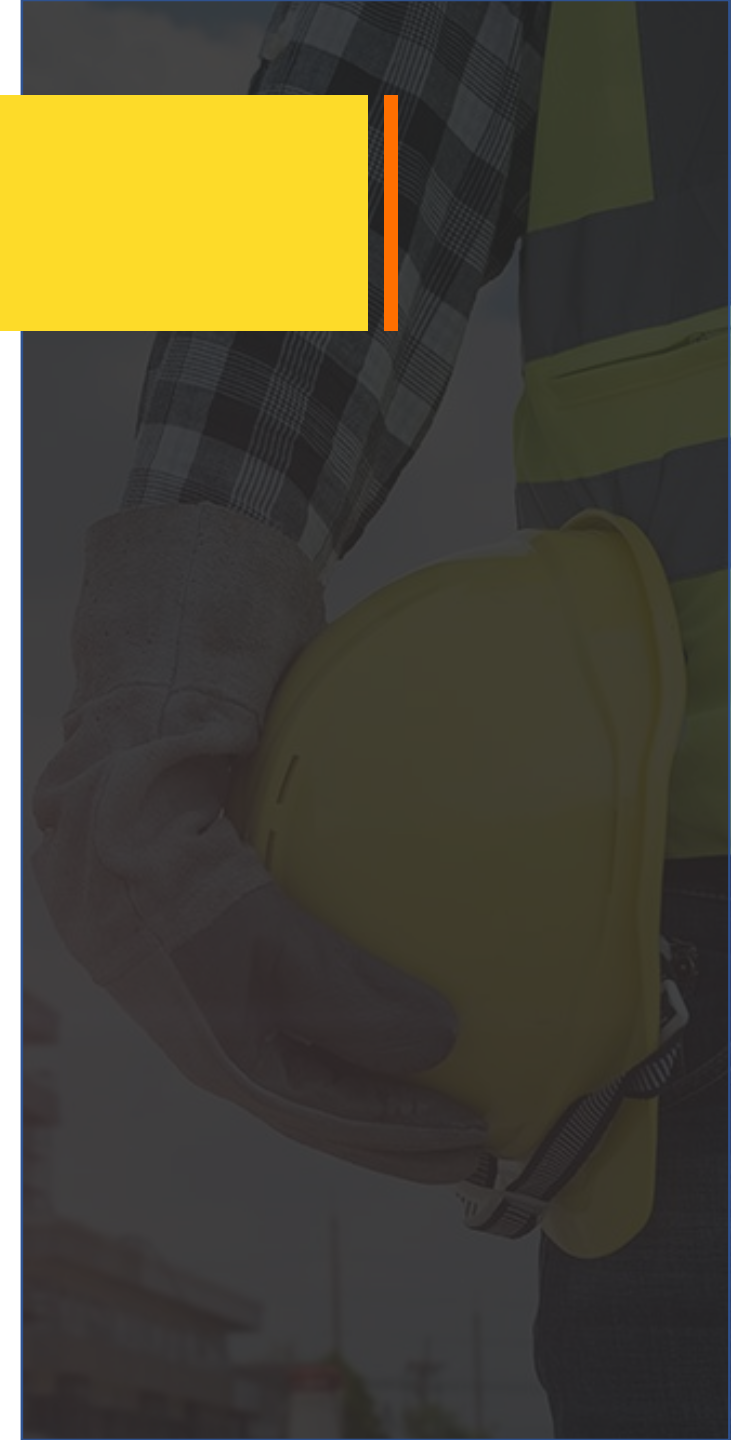
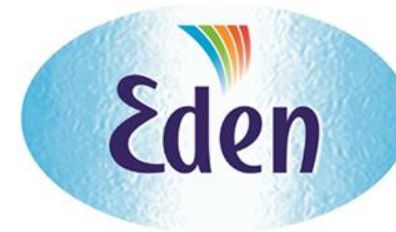

MORGAN ADVANCED MATERIALS PLC

VIRTUAL REALITY PROJECT

PHSS have worked with Morgan Advanced Materials on a number of key environmental health and safety initiatives, including one project to use virtual reality technology to support behavioural change in their UK manufacturing operations.

METHODOLOGY

To develop the virtual reality solution, PHSS engaged with Newcastle-based tech partner and VR/AR specialist, Luminous Group, to produce high-quality fully immersive safety critical scenarios.

Initial work began with a scoping exercise at the Morgan manufacturing facility in Rugby, Warwickshire, where we created a storyboard and developed various scenarios and outcomes.

Luminous then digitised the environment and developed the scenarios off-line at their studios.

The PHSS, Morgan and Luminous teams worked closely to "road-test" and refine the scenarios, before launching the final version.

UNOPS, KIEV

SUPPLY CHAIN DEVELOPMENT

Recent work overseas, particularly with the United Nations Office for Project Services (UNOPS), to deliver a fast turnaround in potentially unstable regions, has further cemented our reputation as a growing international consultancy.




BACKGROUND

Commissioned by the In-Country Head Engineer for UNOPS Ukraine, PHSS visited Kiev during November 2018 to work with the UNOPS team to begin the process of supporting a leadership development programme for Health Safety Environment & Quality activities (HSEQ) in country.

ACTIVITY

The work consisted of the development of a leadership programme, which included printed collateral and translated presentation materials.

The project was focused on leadership development within UNOPS Ukraine HQ in Kiev. A significant part of the work included research into the Ukrainian regulatory systems and how this could be better applied across the UNOPS project portfolio in Ukraine.

WORK PACKAGE PLAN DEVELOPMENT PROJECT




METHODOLOGY

This iconic project will provide much needed modernisation, transforming the subway system and providing the people of Glasgow with a safe, efficient and environmentally friendly mode of transport.

PHSS supported the management of the health and safety planning alongside additional project support to the Racon-Stadler project team, particularly during the installation and commissioning phase of the new rolling stock.
