

Case Study 5 – Fire Safety Risk Assessments

British Millerain - JT Inglis

Established in 1880, British Millerain is the world's premier manufacturer of waxed cotton. Today, British Millerain is a major global supplier of performance textiles for commercial and military applications.

British Millerain commissioned a health and safety audit at its Dundee site. This led to health and safety support during re-roofing works.

Follow on work included a fire safety risk assessment at the site.

Century dying

Century Dying has a long history. Originally part of Allied Textiles and known as the inventor of the high vis jacket, it is now part of British Millerain.

An ongoing investment programme over the last 20 years has provided the capacity to dye and finish over 8 million metres of woven fabrics every year.

The company required a fire safety risk assessment at its manufacturing and warehousing site. This led on to support during major contact works.

Westmill Foods

Westmill is a subsidiary of ABF and one of Europe's largest specialist food companies.

Work commissioned were for fire safety risk assessments at a number of complex food manufacturing sites. These included a rice mill and cooking oil production.

Follow on work includes a pre-acquisition "due diligence" fire risk assessment at a competitor site.
